STONEWALL SPORTHORSES

Beginning with Appaloosa show horses in 1965, Michael Muir began breeding racehorses, starting the careers of the World Champions and multi-million dollar sires Apache Double and Ocala Flight. His horses set world records racing and earned National Grand Championships in the United States, Canada, New Zealand and Australia. What makes this record remarkable is that Michael has lived with multiple sclerosis since the age of fifteen. When the course of his disease prevented him from riding, he turned to driving, and was introduced to the world of draft horses. He began crossing some descendants of his original Appaloosas with Percherons and European warmbloods, developing his eye-catching Stonewall Sporthorses.

These unique warmbloods, with Michael and an international team of equestrians with disabilities, completed an extraordinary 3,000 mile Horsedrawn Journey Across America in 2001, driving wheelchair accessible carriages from the Mission San Diego in California across eleven states to Washington, DC.

Stonewall Sporthorses descend from generations of horses successful at the highest levels of international competition. Michael has been named four times to Team USA, earning world driving medals and championships in Germany, Austria, France and Great Britain.

Michael Muir now serves as Director of Access Adventure, providing outdoor recreation and environmental education for people with disabilities and underserved community members. Access Adventure is supported in part by stallion service fees and the sale of Stonewall Sporthorse foals. The current stallions in the Stonewall Sporthorse breeding program are the imported Friesian, Apollo, and Knabstrupper, Atlantis.
