Thank you for your interest in Access Adventure!

Please complete and return the enclosed forms. They must be filled out completely. The Student Medical History and Physician's Statement must be filled out and signed by the student's medical doctor. This form must be updated annually. The documents should be sent either to info@access-adventure.org, mailed to P.O. Box 2358, Fairfield, CA 94533 or faxed to 707-432-0151.

Once Access Adventure receives the completed application packet you will be contacted to arrange a date for lesson. If you have any questions, please call Access Adventure's Director of Equine Facilitated Therapy, Tineke Jacobsen at 925-708-1139.

When students arrive for lessons, they will be provided with a helmet. We ask that students wear closed-toed shoes; tennis shoes are okay. The student may wear either shorts or long pants, whichever is most comfortable. Bring a hat, sunscreen and insect repellent.

The cost for the assessment is \$50.00.00. Lessons are also \$50.00 and are one-half hour in length. Please make checks payable to Access Adventure.

We request that you give us 24 hour notice if you are not able to make your lesson. A no-show charge of \$25.00 will be assessed if notification is not received. There are no refunds for missed lessons. If you miss three lessons, without giving notice your spot will be given to another student. If we have to cancel lessons due to weather or some other unforeseen circumstance, we will do our best to offer a make-up class. If we are unable to offer a make-up class a lesson fee of \$50 will be refunded.
